

<p><u>Registrations</u></p> <p>What will happen to those already registered for the conference?</p> <p>What will be the process for anyone already registered and who cannot attend in 2021?</p> <p>Who should they contact etc?</p> <p>What, if any, admin fees might they incur for cancellation of their registration?</p>	<p>We will transfer those who had already registered to the conference in 2020 to IAWP 2021.</p> <p>An email has already been sent to registered delegates to inform them of this.</p> <p>However, if the participant would like to cancel their participation in 2021, we will apply Policy 10 on Cancellation.</p> <p>We strongly encourage the participants to transfer their participation to IAWP 2021.</p>
<p><u>Accommodation</u></p> <p>Will existing bookings by delegates at the hotels be honoured and transfer to the new dates? If not what do those with existing bookings need to do?</p> <p>What if those with existing bookings cannot attend the new dates?</p> <p>Will the room rates change for 2021 and if so will the rates for those already booked be honoured?</p>	<p>The hotel gives the same rate as published in the website.</p> <p>All hotels rooms can be rescheduled to the new dates in 2021 via the respective hotel web sites as long as it is made clear the reservation is for the IAWP conference and it was originally booked directly with the hotel.</p> <p>If the reservation was made through a travel agent then any requests to change must go to the relevant travel agency.</p>
<p><u>Transport</u></p> <p>Can you now confirm that the new airport is in full use?</p>	<p>We have communicated with authorities of the airport and they informed us that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - There is direct flight from Singapore-Yogyakarta and Kuala Lumpur-Yogyakarta - Other flights will be transit at Jakarta, Bali
